THE ELITE PROGRAMME BALLET

The Elite Programme Ballet (TEPB) is an intensive programme that focuses on strong foundations in ballet technique with the aim of grooming passionate dancers with potential and wish to pursue dance professionally or gain exposure from competitions or immersions. Dancers are selected via an audition and have to be RAD students of the school.

- Dancers will attend weekly group technique training also receive contemporary dance training (45min) during the last lesson of every month to expand their movement vocabulary (only for TEPB 2 TEPB 4).
- Dancers selected to represent the school at various competitions have to undertake weekly 1.5h private coaching (1 teacher to 2 students).
 *If no schedule can be matched with another dancer for private coaching (1-2), private coaching will be 1-1 (1hr) and subject to respective fees.
- Dancers of TEPB are **not allowed** to represent any other school at competitions for the following genres: Classical ballet, Contemporary, Lyrical and Demi Character.
- TEPB is an 11-month commitment (October to end August/early September of the following year).
- Dancers do not need to audition again for the next cycle.

THE ELITE PROGRAMME CONTEMPORARY

The Elite Programme Contemporary (TEPC) is for dancers who wish to compete in only contemporary and lyrical categories. It aims to nurture passionate dancers with potential and wish to pursue dance professionally or gain exposure from competitions or immersions. Dancers are selected via audition and have to be either RAD or contemporary students of the school.

- Dancers will attend weekly group technique training focusing on contemporary technique drills and fine-tuning of group choreography.
- Dancers selected to represent the school at various competitions have to undertake weekly 1.5h private coaching (1 teacher to 2 students).
 *If no schedule can be matched with another dancer for private coaching (1-2), private coaching will be 1-1 (1hr) and subject to respective fees.
- Dancers of TEPC are **not allowed** to represent any other school at competitions for the following genres: Contemporary and Lyrical.
- TEPC is an 11-month commitment (October to end August/early September of the following year).
- Dancers do not need to audition again for the next cycle.
